Study Questions:

- 3. How does Jeremiah 33:2 testify to the Trinity?
- 4. How does Aaron's blessing testify to the Trinity (Num. 6:23-27)?
- 5. How does Isaiah 6 testify to the Trinity?
- 6. Why don't modern day Rabbis who teach modern day Judaism see such testimony as valid?
- 7. Why didn't the Rabbis in the days of Jesus reject His teaching?
- 8. What light does the Apostle John (a True Rabbi) shed on the subject in chapter twelve of his gospel?
- 9. What role does the Holy Spirit play in receiving the testimony of the scriptures about the Incarnation and the Trinity (see 2 Cor. 3:16-17; 4:3-4)?
- 10. How does the Father testify regarding the Son's role in creation (see Hebrews chapter 1)?

List of Guidelines for Gathering Scripture Passages that testify to the Holy Trinity

- i. When passages speak of God in the plural, we are taught about the plurality of persons
- ii. When passages combine singular verbs with plural nouns, we are taught about the unity in the divine essence while maintaining the plurality in persons. Singular verbs with a plural noun show forth common action by more than one.
- iii. When the name or title of God is repeated thrice, we are taught to confess three persons of the Holy Trinity
